

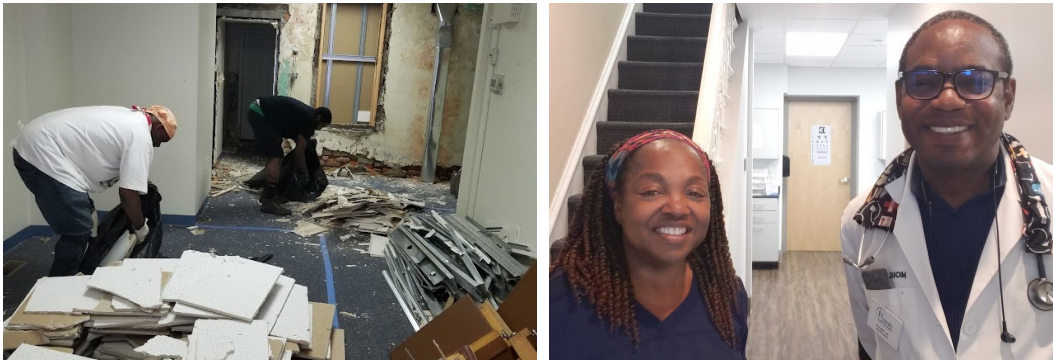

Just five years ago, the clinic site was being demolished. The pictures tell the story of how it got even better.

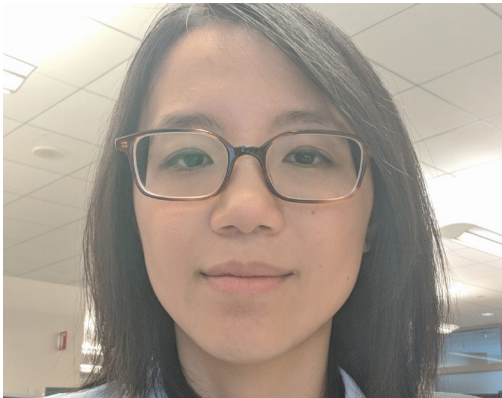


The demolition went from blight to bright. Five years later, the office runs efficiently offering both in clinic, on site, home and telemedicine visits.

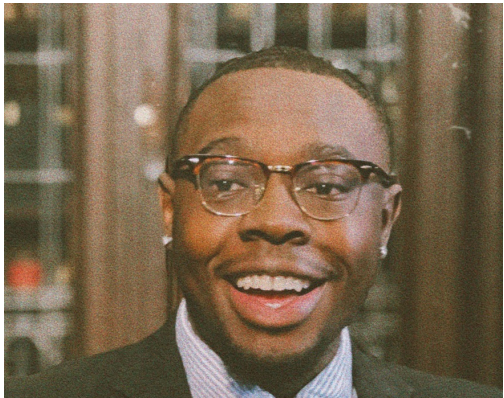
